OUR COURSES

After the foundation year, during which students become familiar with the world of applied arts and interior design, students opt for a 4 year course interior architecture and design.

The Interior Architecture and Design course leads to professions concerned with improving the quality of living conditions and maintaining a sustainable environment. Students work most often on live projects.

Year

Year 2: students develop a plastic approach to space and acquire the skills necessary to transfer this into interior design.

Year 4: students determine and develop their personal design intent. Projects acquire a social dimension. Students work in the studio together on the same project, becoming accustomed to the tutor dynamic.

Drawing is an essential skill required in the field of design. The foundation year course reaches beyond a purely technical training, teaching the multifaceted aspects of this discipline.

Year 3: the student becomes familiar with the different stages of a project. Students strengthen their abilities by applying experience from previous years, developing projects into practice.

This last year is the consolidation of the skills and experience of the previous years. The objective to demonstrate working independence: develop a brief of specifications, master the creative tools, project methodology, develop a concept, demonstrate aesthetic and creative design intent, present a project.



EDUCATIONAL GOALS

At the end of the course, the student must be able to:

- Analyse and determine the adequacy of the architectural design of a place
- Design and create a project with a personal design intent
- Communicate and organise, from conception to completion.
